VENDOR REQUIREMENTS:

- Festival grounds will be open at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, September 26th for setting up. All construction must be done and booths open for business by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 27th.
- Water is available, but no hook-ups are allowed for any individual. We must share the water faucets.
- There is a \$15 fee for electrical hook-up. Specify below if needed.
- No dogs or other animals are allowed to roam free on festival grounds.
- Booths must remain open during festival hours, which are: 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., Saturday, September 27th and 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Sunday, September 28th
- Vehicles must be parked in the designated vendor parking area. Remember, the farther away you park, the closer a prospective buyer can park!
- Vendors are responsible for the daily clean up of their booth space.
- Booths must be removed from the grounds by 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 28th, unless prearranged.
- Food Vendors must have a copy of their food license or permit on hand. Must have valid propane permit for Cascade Locks if using propane. Application is available online at www.cascadelocksfire.com
- RV Parking is available at the Port of Cascade Locks campground on a first-come-first-served basis. Nightly fees are \$25 for a full hook-up and \$15 for no hook-up.
- Verify that all items in your booth are appropriate for ALL age groups, including the very young. This is a family event. The festival committee reserves the right to disallow the sale of all inappropriate items.
- *All booths must comply with all state and local ordinances and are subject to inspection by the Fire Marshall.*

LIABILITY:

Although we take all precautions possible to protect and safeguard the exhibits, we cannot be responsible for loss, damage, or theft. Security will be provided Friday and Saturday night from 9:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m. Vendor agrees to hold harmless the Port of Cascade Locks, The City of Cascade Locks and the Festival Of Nations, together with their officers, elected officials and employees, from any liability or damages for property damage or bodily injury, which may arise from all causes of any kind related to vendors use of any City or Port property in connection with the Festival Of Nations event to be held on September 27th, and 28th, 2008.
